Members of St. Martin's Choir have donated £250.00 towards the construction of a new church primary school at St. Paul's Church, Kawama. The site is located within the grounds of an Anglican church, in a township south of Ndola and when complete the new school at Kawama will provide education for 100 young children who otherwise would be deprived of any primary education.
