Readings

Isaiah 62.1-5

This passage uses the striking imagery of marriage to depict the intensity of the relationship between God and Jerusalem (and by implication the whole of creation) as being like that between a bridegroom and a bride.

1 Corinthians 12.1-11

St Paul begins this passage by showing how it is through the Holy Spirit that we recognise the Lordship of Jesus Christ. He then goes on to identify some of the consequences of receiving the Spirit in terms of the gifts that are given to the people of God.

John 2.1-11

In John's Gospel, the wedding at Cana is the scene for Jesus' first miracle. Here Christ's authority over creation is a reflection of the abundance and transforming effect of God's love for us.
