Bind us together Tree

We are going to make a Christmas Tree with knitted green leaves.

The instructions for the knitted leaves are:

Using size 9uk/3.75mm needles and double knitting wool in any shade of green, cast on 30 stitches and knit in plain stitch until the work measures 12 inches and cast off.

Once you have knitted your leaves - simply bring them in to St Martin's and we will sew them into a point and assemble them together to make "a tree". After the festival volunteers will be required to sew the leaves into blankets for charity.

We will also be making pompoms in any bright colour for the tree, simply by making two cardboard circles up to 3 inches in diameter.
